V. J. TORR'S MS. NOTEBOOKS

IN 1966 the Society acquired several hundred MS. notebooks belonging to the late V. J. Torr, Esq. They were practically all concerned with church architecture and history and were copied from MSS. in the libraries of Lambeth Palace, the British Museum, Canterbury Cathedral, and elsewhere, or from printed sources.

All the notebooks containing copies of MSS. concerned with Kent have been retained and also copies of printed material concerned with the county and not easily accessible.
